#### What is the MTC?

- Multiplication tables check (MTC) determines whether children can fluently recall their multiplication tables.
- Designed for schools to help teaching staff identify which children need more support to learn their tables.
- ► There is no pass mark/threshold no children will need to re-sit the check.
- ▶ All tables up to 12 x 12, with the 6, 7, 8, 9 and 12 times tables being more likely to be asked.

#### How does it work?

- The check will be carried out on an iPad.
- Children enter answers using the on screen key pad.
- Children will have 6 seconds to answer each question.
- 25 questions in total with a 3 second pause in between each question.
- Children will not see their individual results at the time of the check.
- Some children will be eligible for access arrangements your child's teacher or the school SENCo will have a conversation with you about this nearer to the time of the check if this is the case.

### When is the MTC?

- 2 week window from Monday 2<sup>nd</sup> June 2025.
- ► There is no set day or time for children to take the check you will not be told the specific day your child takes the check.

## What are school doing to prepare?

- Explicit teaching of the times tables. This begins in year 2.
- Daily practise at recalling times table facts.
- Weekly quiz children are encouraged to beat their score each week.
- Rewards and incentives to help encourage children to want to practise and improve.
- ► Targeted interventions to support children struggling with a particular times table.
- Keeping it fun and low stakes!


## What can you do to prepare at home?

- Reassure your child and do not panic or worry!
- Speak to your child's teacher or Miss Rooney (Maths Lead) or Miss Bhogaita (SENCo) if you have any worries or concerns.
- Support your child to practise their tables at home little and often is best!
- Make times tables fun!
