General Information:

The School Day

The school day begins at 8:40am where children will be welcomed into Nursery by a member of staff. We are operating a 'soft start' whereby you can drop your child off at the classroom door between 8:40 and 8:50am and pass on any key messages. We encourage children to be independent when they arrive and ask that parents say goodbye to children before they enter the classroom door where possible. The door will be closed at 8:50am so that the register can be taken. If you arrive after 8:50am please take your child to the school reception to sign in.

The school day finishes at 3:20pm where you will collect your child from their classroom door.

For children attending a morning session, drop off will be at the classroom door at 8:40am and pick up will be at the main office at 11:40am.

For children attending an afternoon session, drop off will be at the main office at 12:20pm and pick up will be at the classroom door at 3:20pm.

Attendance

If your child is ill and cannot attend school, please call the school office in the morning so that we can record their absence. Please call each morning of their absence to keep us informed. If your child becomes ill during the school day, a phone call will be made to you to come and collect them.

As a school, we take our safeguarding responsibilities very seriously. When children have been absent from school for 5 days, we will carry out a home visit to check in with you and make sure that all is okay. This is a school policy, but please rest assured that this is purely for us to make sure that everything is okay and that your child is safe and well.

If you would like to change the hours that your child attends nursery, please contact a member of the office team and we will look into this for you. We will try our best to accommodate your wishes, however priority for places will go to children who are attending Monday to Friday on a regular basis.

School Uniform

Our school uniform consists of:

- A navy cardigan or jumper (plain or with the school logo)
- A white polo shirt (plain or with the school logo)
- Grey/black trousers, skirt or pinafore
- Black school shoes or boots no trainers

Lunchtimes

Children in Nursery are welcome to order a delicious, nutritious hot meal from our school kitchen or bring a packed lunch to school. There is a weekly menu that can be viewed on the school website so that you can discuss the options with your child. If you do not like the main choice on a particular day, there will be an alternative option available too. We can also provide alternatives for children who are vegetarian or have allergies or intolerances. You do not need to book school meals in advance. We ask that packed lunches include healthy foods – no fizzy drinks or sweets. We are also a nut free school.
